

2021-2022 A Brand New School Year!

We are looking forward to seeing everyone tomorrow! Please take a few minutes to read through these reminders for tomorrow.

1. See the Traffic Plan **attached to this email** for the Drop-off and Pick-up points.
2. Please be aware of the time on the first day in order to get your pictures and see the younger students to their class. The bell rings at 8:30am so it is important to say your goodbyes and allow the classroom teacher to take it from there. It is not unusual for some younger students to have a little anxiety when you leave. Know they are in good hands and we will contact you if necessary. :)
3. If you haven't signed up for Extended Care please make sure you do that tonight. Go to <https://www.newlifeacademystl.com/k12extendedcare> , click on the Extended Care button and follow the instructions on that page.
4. If you want your child to have a hot lunch from NLA make sure you enroll in HotLunch Online - <https://newlifechristianschool.h1.hotlunchonline.net/frontend.php>
5. When you pickup tomorrow between 3:30pm and 3:45pm, make sure you follow the NLA Traffic Plan and be in your designated lines. All parents must use the car line for pickup. Do not come inside to pick-up. Our staff will assist your child to your vehicle. Please make sure your pick-up # is prominently displayed to make this easier for us. Thanks for your patience as we work through the process of name and face recognition at the end of these first days.

Part of our process of familiarization is by having families with students in both K-5 and 6-12 **go to both pick-up areas** for the 1st week of school. After our first full week you will have the option to send your 6-12 grade students down to the K-5 pick-up area for combined pick-up. If you are planning on doing a combined pick-up you will need to email office@newlifeschool.com to get on the list.

4. We have implemented a couple of changes in picking up from Extended Care after 3:45pm. These address safety concerns and are overall good general practices. Please report directly to the check-out table when picking up your child(ren). To help in this process please bring your child's number in with you each day next week. This will speed things up a bit as the aftercare staff gets to know everyone.
6. For those who may be waiting on uniforms to come in from Fischer's we are accepting the following until they arrive. Boys - Black pants, white or gray polo style shirt. Girls - Gray or Black Skirt with white or black polo style shirt. Please read through the details of our Dress Code. This will address the following appearance code:

Appearance

1. No cosmetics, which alter natural appearance, such as eye shadow, fingernail polish, lipstick, etc.
2. No jewelry. One ring (class ring or purity) and must be of conservative styling.
3. Boys' hairstyle must be a standard, conservative cut; off the collar and ears; face must be clean-

shaven.

4. Hats are not to be worn in the building 5. No altering of natural hair color.
